Free Store

- Assistance with clothing and personal items (may receive monthly)
 - NO referral needed to receive services
- Coffee, light snacks, and other connections to mainstream resources (may receive weekly)
- Get To Work-access to work boots and clothing (available every 6 months)
 - NO referral needed
- Showers and haircuts provided by Fresh Start Durham (may come weekly)

Emergency Shelter

- Offering emergency shelter services over cold weather months from November 1 - March 31
- Have provided both congregate and noncongregate shelter options
 - o Congregate shelter does not require referral
 - Non-congregate shelter requires a referral through Entry Point
- Site location changes from year to year
- Stay tuned closer to the 2024-2025 season for additional details

Office Hours

- Walk-in hours 9am 1pm Monday Friday (with the exception of Tuesday, which is Free Store)
- Providing a variety of resources: (no referral needed)

Long Term Case Management

Internal Referrals Only

- Holistic long-term services no matter where folks are on their housing journey (homeless, accessing housing, and housed)
